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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section 101 of chapter 4 of the Revised  
Statutes relating to harbors.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That section 101 of chapter 4 of the Revised  
2 Statutes be amended by substituting for the word "may"  
3 wherever it appears in said section the word 'shall,' so that  
4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 101. The municipal authorities of all maritime towns  
6 and plantations shall make rules and regulations for the keep-  
7 ing open of convenient channels for the passage of ves-  
8 sels in the harbors and waterways of the towns for which  
9 they act, and shall establish the boundary lines of such chan-  
10 nels, and assign suitable portions of their harbors for anchor-  
11 age.'
