STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT granting Ithiel C. Blackman the right to maintain a ferry.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Ithiel C. Blackman of Lincoln, is hereby author-

- 2 ized to establish and maintain a ferry for the space of ten
- 3 years, across the Penobscot river, between the towns of Lin-
- 4 coln and Chester, in Penobscot county, from the terminus of
- 5 the road now existing on the Lincoln shore, near the station
- 6 of the Maine Central Railroad at Lincoln Center, and the
- 7 terminus of the road as now existing on the Chester shore;
- 8 with the right to keep and maintain suitable boats to be pro-
- 9 pelled by wire and trucks, oars, sails, steam, or some other

10 power, for the safe conveyance and transportation of passen-11 gers, teams, animals, carriages and freight.

- Sect. 2. The rates of toll as now adopted by the commis2 sioners of said county for the present ferry at said place shall
 3 govern during said ten-year period, and all the regulations
 4 now adopted by said commissioners as to the hours that said
 5 ferry shall be in operation shall also govern, and the said
 6 Blackman shall be liable for charging unauthorized rates of
 7 toll in excess of established rates as provided by the Revised
 8 Statutes. For unreasonable neglect and delay to transport
 9 either passengers or freight during the hours as determined
 10 by said commissioners, there shall be a penalty of not more
 11 than fifty dollars, to be recovered by the party injured, in an
 12 action on the case.
 - Sect. 3. Should said Blackman desire to give up said ferry, 2 and the rights herein granted, he shall give the county com-3 missioners of said county three months notice, in writing, of 4 his intentions to do so, and said commissioners may then 5 appoint a ferryman for said place.
 - Sect. 4. No other ferry shall be established on said river 2 nearer than South Lincoln on the south and the Fleming 3 ferry on the north.
