IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to repeal the first clause of sub-division entitled "In Washington County" of section one, chapter four hundred seven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three entitled "An Act to consolidate and revise certain laws relating to closing certain lakes and ponds to ice-fishing, etc."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The first clause, namely: "It shall be unlawful 2 to fish through the ice for any kind of fish in Narraguagus 3 lake in Beddington," of sub-division entitled "In Washington 4 County," of section one of chapter four hundred seven of the 5 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three, is 6 hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
