IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT for the protection of fish in the tributaries of Upper
Kezar pond, Oxford county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No person shall put, or allow the same to be
2 done by any person within his employ, into any of the tribu-
3 taries of Upper Kezar pond, in Lovell, Oxford county, any
4 mill waste, slabs, edgings, sawdust, or any other mill waste
5 of a fibrous nature created in the manufacture of any sawn
6 or planed lumber, or to place or deposit the same on the
7 banks of any of these tributaries in such negligent or careless
8 manner, that the same shall fall or be washed into any of
9 said tributaries, or with the intent that the same shall fall, or
10 be washed into any of said tributaries.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
