### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 13 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes relative to the manner of hunting and catching wild hares or rabbits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 13 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by adding after the words "Hancock
- 3 county" at the end of said section the words, 'and in Oxford,
- 4 Penobscot and Piscataquis counties it may and shall be law-
- 5 ful to catch wild hares or rabbits in box traps,' so that the
- 6 last sentence of said section, as amended, shall read as fol-
- 7 lows: 'This section shall not apply to Hancock county; and
- 8 in Oxford, Penobscot and Piscataquis counties it may and
- 9 shall be lawful to catch wild hares or rabbits in box traps.'
