### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of oysters from Dyer's and Sheepscot rivers in the county of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. No person shall, between the date of the
- 2 approval of this act and the first day of April in the year nine-
- 3 teen hundred and seven, take or in any manner destroy, or
- 4 interfere with the growth of oysters in the waters of Dyer's
- 5 and Sheepscot rivers in the county of Lincoln, under a pen-
- 6 alty of not less than five nor more than fifty dollars for each
- 7 and every violation of this section.
  - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
