STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the removal of bodies of deceased persons
from the Freedom cemetery, in the town of Freedom.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The town of Freedom is hereby empowered to
2 authorize some suitable person to take up from the old ceme-
3 tery in the town of Freedom, known as Freedom cemetery,
4 the bodies and remains of all deceased persons buried therein,
5 and all headstones and markers at the graves therein, and
6 remove the said bodies and remains to the Pleasant Hill
7 cemetery, so called, in said town, and there decently inter the
8 same, and properly reset such headstones and markers over
9 such dead bodies and remains at the expense of said town.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
