STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Mattawamkeag lake.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take or catch
2 any fish, except eels, at any time in the waters of Mattawam-
3 keag lake in Aroostook county except with single hook and
4 line for the consumption in the family of the person taking
5 or catching the same.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any portion of this act shall
2 be liable to penalty provided in the general law for illegal
3 fishing.
