IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend paragraph six, entitled "Oxford County," of section three of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, relating to fishing in the Magalloway river and its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph six of section three of chapter 407 2 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, is hereby amended 3 by striking out the words "or in any of the tributaries of said 4 river north of said falls," in the twenty-third and twenty-5 fourth lines of said paragraph, and by adding thereto the fol-6 lowing: 'and it shall be unlawful to fish for, take or catch 7 any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries of said 8 Magalloway river above Aziscohos falls.' .
