STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Mattawamkeag Lumber Company to erect and maintain piers and booms in the west branch of the Mattawamkeag river and Fish stream.

Be it enacted by the Senale and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The Mattawamkeag Lumber Company, duly 2 organized and existing under the laws of the State of Maine,
- 3 its successors and assigns are hereby authorized and empow-
- 4 ered to locate, erect and maintain in the town of Island Falls,
- 5 in the Mattawamkeag river, between the highway bridge and
- 6 the mouth of Fish stream and in said Fish stream from the
- 7 mouth thereof to the railroad bridge, piers and booms for the
- 8 purpose of collecting, holding, separating and sorting out
- 9 logs and other lumber coming down said Mattawamkeag

10 river and Fish stream. Provided, however, that sufficient II sorting gaps are constructed, maintained and used for the 12 passage of logs and other lumber through said boom, and 13 provided further that said piers and storage booms shall not 14 occupy more than half of said river and said Fish stream. 15 Said piers and booms shall be so located, constructed, main-16 tained and used that logs and lumber running down said 17 river and said Fish stream not destined for use and manu-18 facture at the mills at Island Falls shall not be unreasonably 19 impeded or delayed, and in no case shall logs and other lum-20 ber be delayed longer than ninety-six hours, and the logs 21 and lumber of other parties, when stopped for sorting shall 22 be turned by as soon as they practically can be sorted and 23 separated from the logs and lumber destined for manufacture 24 at said mills. And in case said logs belonging to other 25 parties are delayed for a longer period than twenty-four 26 hours and less than ninety-six hours, then said company, its 27 successors and assigns shall pay to the other owners of logs 28 the expenses caused by such delay. Any stray logs or other 29 lumber not destined for use and manufacture at the mills at 30 Island Falls, if found in the booms of said company shall be 31 turned out by said company at its own charge and expense 32 prior to the passage of the rear of the drive. In case strays 33 are not turned out as aforesaid during the passage of the 34 drive and remain therein after the rear of the drive has 35 passed the company's boom, said company, its successors and 36 assigns shall pay to the owners of said strays the full market 37 value thereof. The said company shall take into its booms 38 all unmarked logs found in the drive and make and keep an 30 accurate account thereof and within sixty days shall account 40 for and pay to every owner of logs other than those manu-41 factured at the mills in Island Falls, such proportion of the 42 full market value of said logs as his logs in the drive bear to 43 the whole number driven and sorted.

Sect. 2. Said Mattawamkeag Lumber Company, its suc-2 cessors and assigns, by aid of such piers and booms are 3 hereby authorized and empowered to separate and sort out 4 from the logs and other lumber coming down said river, all 5 logs and other lumber destined for use and manufacture at 6 the mills at Island Falls. Provided, however, if upon the 7 approach of the rear of the principal drive of logs at the 8 boom of said company herein authorized to be maintained, 9 it shall appear to the person in charge of such drive that said 10 company has not sufficient men to sort and turn by the logs II and other lumber arriving at said booms, so that such drive 12 may be detained beyond the allowance of time hereinbefore 13 contained, such person, upon notice in writing to said com-14 pany, left at its office, shall have the right to put men of his 15 own selection upon said booms to expedite the sorting and 16 turning by of the logs and other lumber in such drive, who 17 shall be paid by said company. And said company is also 18 authorized and empowered to hold within the piers and 10 booms mentioned in this act and located, erected and main-20 tained as aforesaid, all logs and other lumber coming down 21 said Mattawamkeag river and said Fish stream which are 22 destined and intended for use and manufacture at the mills 23 at Island Falls.

Sect. 3. The person or corporation having charge of and 2 being responsible for the principal drive down said Matta-3 wamkeag river shall have the right at any time to appoint 4 an agent, who is hereby authorized and empowered and 5 whose duty it shall be to supervise and inspect the sorting 6 of the logs and other lumber running through the booms 7 herein authorized, and said company at the beginning of 8 every driving season or at the time of the appointment of 9 such agent shall furnish such agent a list of marks upon all 10 logs and other lumber intended to be manufactured at the 11 mills at Island Falls, and such agents shall see to it that the

12 logs and other lumber not intended for manufacture at the 13 mills at Island Falls are not unreasonably detained or delayed 14 in said booms. The compensation of said agent shall not 15 exceed two dollars fifty cents per day and shall be paid by 16 said Mattawamkeag Lumber Company.

Sect. 4. In the event that in any driving season said com2 pany does not avail itself of the privileges herein granted to
3 take, hold, sort and detain logs, it shall before the arrival of
4 the head of any drive, hang and maintain during such season
5 booms around its piers, connected above the uppermost of
6 said piers to one shore or the other of said Mattawamkeag
7 river so that said piers shall not impede the driving of logs
8 and lumber down said river.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
