STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing Samuel Sylvester to build a wharf into the waters of Small Point Harbor, in the town of Phippsburg, in said State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. Samuel Sylvester and his heirs or assigns are
- 2 hereby authorized to construct and maintain a wharf from
- 3 his shore front at Small Point Harbor in the town of Phipps-
- 4 burg into the waters of said harbor to Goose Rock or so far
- 5 into the tide waters of said harbor from any point on said
- 6 shore front northerly from said rock as may be determined
- 7 by the municipal officers of said town.
 - Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
