IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Houlton and Woodstock  
Electric Railroad Company.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Houl-  
2 ton and Woodstock Electric Railroad Company which were  
3 granted by chapter one hundred and sixty of the Private and  
4 Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred and three, are  
5 hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act  
6 and the persons named in said act, their associates and suc-  
7 cessors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that  
8 were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same  
9 manner and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
