### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section 8 of chapter 117 of the Revised Statutes relating to constables.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section eight of chapter one hundred and seven-

- 2 teen of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out in the first line of said section the word "travel" and
- 4 inserting in the second line of said section after the word
- 5 "cents" the following, 'and for travel six cents a mile each
- 6 way,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
  - 'Sect. 8. The fees of constables for the service and return
- 8 of each venire, are one dollar and fifty cents, and for travel

9 six cents a mile each way, to be paid out of the county treas10 ury; and for services which may be performed either by a
11 deputy sheriff or a constable, the constable is allowed the
12 same fees as a deputy sheriff, unless otherwise provided.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
