STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE authorizing a temporary loan for the year nineteen
hundred and six.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the
2 treasurer of State be, and is hereby authorized to procure on
3 the faith of the State, if he shall deem it necessary, at any
4 time during the year nineteen hundred and six, a temporary
5 loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof
6 as may be needed.

Resolved, That the treasurer of State be, and hereby is
8 authorized to give notes in behalf of the State, payable within
9 three years from the date hereof, for such portions of the
10 loan hereby authorized, as may be required.
