IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT establishing a close time for fishing on Thompson pond, from September first to January first of the following year.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

There shall be an annual close time on Thompson pond, 2 situated in the counties of Oxford, Cumberland and Andros- 3 coggin, from September first to January first of the following 4 year, during which time it shall be unlawful to fish for any 5 kind of fish at any time, under the same penalty as is pro- 6 vided in the general law for illegal fishing.
