IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT changing the close time for fishing in Long pond, in Cumberland county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

There shall be an annual close time in which it shall be 2 unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill in any way any land-3 locked salmon, trout or togue in Long pond, situated in the 4 towns of Bridgton, Naples and Harrison in the county of 5 Cumberland, from October first until the first day of April 6 following of each year, under the same penalty as is provided 7 in the general law for illegal fishing.
