AN ACT changing the close time for fishing in Long pond, in  
Cumberland county.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

There shall be an annual close time in which it shall be  
2 unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill in any way any land-  
3 locked salmon, trout or togue in Long pond, situated in the  
4 towns of Bridgton, Naples and Harrison in the county of  
5 Cumberland, from October first until the first day of April  
6 following of each year, under the same penalty as is provided  
7 in the general law for illegal fishing.
