IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to permit ice fishing in Fourth Buttermilk and Little Benson ponds, in Piscataquis county, during the month of February.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be lawful for residents of this State to fish for and
2 take fish through the ice during the month of February of
3 each year, as provided in the general law, in Fourth Butter-
4 milk and Little Benson ponds, in the county of Piscataquis.
