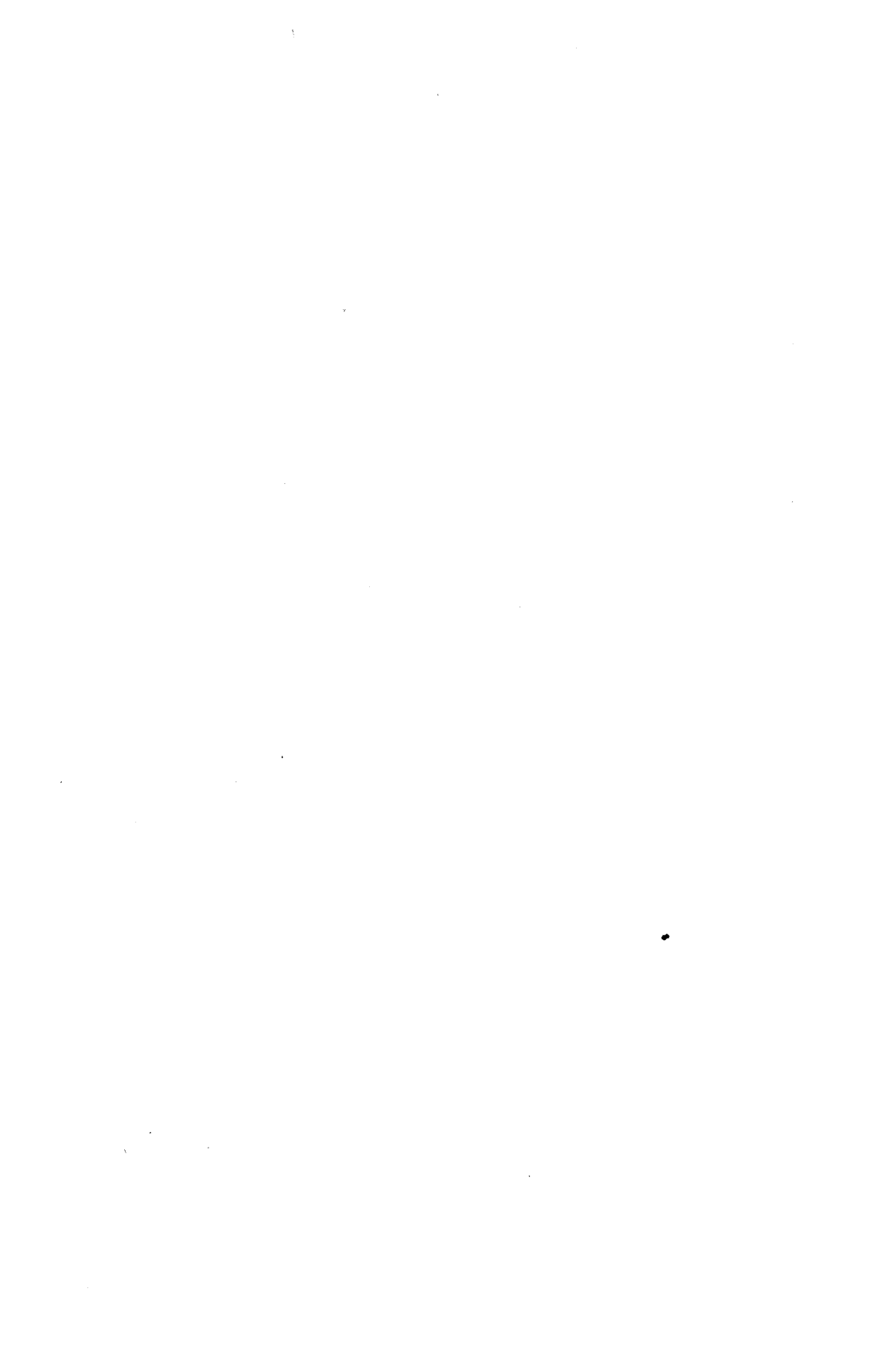
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT regulating the close time for fishing in Sandy and Half
Moon streams and their tributaries, and the tributaries to
Unity pond, in Waldo county.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. There shall be an annual close time in which it
2 shall be unlawful to fish for any kind of fish at any time on
3 the streams known as Sandy and Half Moon streams and
4 their tributaries, and the tributaries to Unity pond, all situ-
5 ated in Waldo county, from the first day of July to the first
6 day of May of each year.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law for illegal fishing.
