IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend chapter 321 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, relating to the taking of smelts from tributaries of Upper Kezar pond, in Lovell, Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter 321, of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, is hereby amended, by inserting in second line of said section, between the words "tributary" and "of," the words, 'except Mill brook,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 2. It shall be unlawful at any time to take smelts from any tributary except Mill brook of Upper Kezar pond in Oxford county.'
