STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Moxie pond, in the county of Somerset.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section I. In addition to the general law regulating fish-

- 2 ing it shall be unlawful for any one person in any one day
- 3 to take, catch or kill more than ten pounds of fish in Moxie
- 4 pond, in Somerset county, or in the tributaries thereof, and
- 5 no one person shall be permitted to carry away therefrom
- 6 more than fifteen pounds of fish at the close of any one period
- 7 of fishing regardless of how many days such period of fish-
- 8 ing may cover.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act

- 2 shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
- 3 general law of the State for illegal fishing.
