
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend that portion of section 3 of chapter 407 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903 relating to the time and number of fish that can be taken in the streams lying wholly or partly in the towns of Freeman and Salem.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

So much of section three of chapter 407 of the Private and

- 2 Special Laws of 1903 as prohibits fishing, other than as
- 3 provided in the general laws of the State, in the streams
- 4 lying wholly or partly in the towns of Freeman and Salem,
- 5 is hereby repealed.
