IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing at all times in the tributaries to Squa Pan lake, in Aroostook county.

Re it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill at any

- 2 time in any way any kind of fish in the inlet stream, so called,
- 3 to Squa Pan lake in Aroostook county, or in the east branch
- 4 of said inlet, so called, above what is known and called
- 5 "Thomas Thibadeau's lower landing," under the same pen-
- 6 alty as is provided in the general law for illegal fishing.
