## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit fishing in Break Neck brook and its tributaries, situated partly in the towns of Sebago and Baldwin, county of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind

- 2 of fish at any time in Break Neck brook or in any of its tribu-
- 3 taries, situated partly in the towns of Sebago and Baldwin,
- 4 county of Cumberland, under the same penalty as is provided
- 5 in the general law of the State for illegal fishing.
