STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE $\mbox{HUNDRED AND FIVE}.$

AN ACT relating to the use of purse and drag seines in waters east of the west shore of the Penobscot river and bay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful for any citizen of the State

- 2 to use purse and drag seines for the purpose of taking her-
- 3 ring, from September fifteenth to December first in each
- 4 year, in all bays and inlets, rivers and harbors of the State
- 5 east of the west shore of the Penobscot bay and river, ex-
- 6 cept as provided in sections two and three of this act.

Sect. 2. No person shall set any net or seine for the pur-

2 pose of taking herring in the above waters within six hun-

- 3 dred feet of the mouth of any weir, under a penalty of one
- 4 hundred and fifty dollars for each offense.
 - Sect. 3. The provisions of section one shall not modify or
- 2 affect any rights or privileges heretofore granted concern-
- 3 ing spawning grounds in said waters.
- Sect. 4. It shall be unlawful for any person not a citizen of
- 2 this State to use any purse or drag seines for the purpose of
- 3 taking herring in the waters specified in section one. Any
- 4 person violating the provisions of this section shall be liable
- 5 to a penalty of five hundred dollars for each offense, to be
- 6 recovered in an action of debt.
- Sect. 5. So many of the provisions of the general law and
- 2 of special acts heretofore passed as are inconsistent with the
- 3 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
