IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section ninety-five of chapter forty-nine of
the Revised Statutes, relating to notice of injury to casualty
insurance companies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section ninety-five of chapter forty-nine of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as
3 follows:

‘Section 95. No conditions, stipulations or agreements
5 contained in any application for insurance in any foreign or
6 domestic casualty or accident insurance company, or con-
7 tained in any policy issued by any such company, or any way
8 made by any such company, limiting the time within which
9 notice of the accident or injury, sickness, or death, shall be

10 given to such company, to a period of less than thirty days
11 after the happening of the accident or injury, or death, or the
12 beginning of the sickness, shall be valid. Said notice may
13 be given to the company insuring, at any time within thirty
14 days after the happening of the accident or injury, or death,
15 or beginning of the sickness, and shall be valid and binding
16 on the company.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
