IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the North Brooklin Wharf Company to extend a wharf into the tide waters of Bluehill bay, at North Brooklin, Hancock county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Leroy R. Flye, his associates and assigns, to be known as the North Brooklin Wharf Company, are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a wharf, on the shore of Bluehill bay, county of Hancock, and to extend the same, far enough into the tide waters of said bay, to allow the landing of boats and steamers. Said wharf to be located at North Brooklin, about one and one-half miles from the head of Harriman's Cove, on the westerly side of said bay, on or near Benjamin Dodge's Point, so called.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
