STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter fifty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and twenty-one, as amended by chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and forty-eight, as amended by chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, as amended by chapter four hundred and thirteen of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, relating to extending the time of controlling the water at the alewife fishery at Damariscotta Mills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section three of chapter fifty of the Private and
2 Special Laws of eighteen hundred and twenty-one, as
3 amended by chapter one hundred and sixty-one of the Pri-

4 vate and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and forty-eight,
5 as amended by chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the
6 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-
7 two, as amended by chapter four hundred and thirteen of the
8 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, is
9 hereby further amended so that it shall be lawful for the joint
10 fish committee of the towns of Nobleboro and Newcastle to
11 control the water and sluiceways at the alewife fishery at
12 Damariscotta Mills from the twentieth day of April to the
13 fifteenth day of July annually; provided that said control in
14 no way interferes with the rights which the Damariscotta
15 Mills Water Power Company now have.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
