### STATE OF MAINE.

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the First Baptist church of Hampden to convey certain property to the Maine Baptist Missionary Convention.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The First Baptist Church of Hampden, county

- 2 of Penobscot, is hereby authorized and empowered to convey
- 3 by deed of gift to the Maine Baptist Missionary Convention
- 4 all its property in the town of Hampden, Penobscot county. Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
