IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Hallowell Trust Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Hallowell Trust Company, which were granted by chapter 475 of the Private and Special Laws of 1901, and extended by chapter 188 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, are hereby extended for two years from the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act, and their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
