

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-four thousand eight hun2 dred and fifty dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and
3 in behalf of the Maine State prison, to be expended under
4 the direction and supervision of the governor and council.
5 Forty-five hundred dollars for repairs of buildings; two hun6 dred dollars, watchman's clock; one hundred and fifty dol7 lars, hospital appliances; ten thousand dollars, current
8 expenses. Ten thousand dollars, current expenses for the

9 year nineteeff hundred and six.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve calls for \$10,000 each year for 1905 and 1906 to pay the running expenses of the State prison, and an additional sum of \$4,850 for repairs on buildings, watchman's clock, and hospital supplies.
