IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to apportion the expenses of bridges between towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Whenever a highway hereafter located crosses

- 2 any river which divides towns, the expense of constructing,
- 3 maintaining and repairing any bridge across such river shall
- 4 be borne by such towns in proportion to their last State valu-
- 5 ation prior to such location.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
