STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Maine and New Hampshire Railroad.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All the rights, powers and privileges of the

- 2 Maine and New Hampshire Railroad which were granted by
- 3 chapter 248 of the Private and Special Laws of 1903, are
- 4 hereby extended for and during the period of two years
- 5 from the twenty-fourth day of March, A. D. 1905. And all
- 6 the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said
- 7 act, may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for
- 8 the same purposes as provided in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
