IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section four of chapter one hundred and
twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes relating to injury to
property used for public water supplies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section four of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "or town" in the second line, and inserting in place
4 thereof the words 'town or municipal corporation,' and also
5 by striking out in the fifth line thereof the words "or town,"
6 and inserting in place thereof the words 'town or municipal
7 corporations,' so that said section as amended shall read as
8 follows:

'Section 4. Whoever wilfully injures any property of any
10 water company, or of any city, town or municipal corpora-

11 tion used by it in supplying water to its inhabitants, shall be
12 punished by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars and
13 by imprisonment not exceeding one year; and such persons
14 shall also forfeit and pay to such water company, city, town
15 or municipal corporation, three times the amount of actual
16 damages sustained, to be recovered in an action on the case.'
