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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to restore the jurisdiction of trial justices in the town  
of Fayette, in the county of Kennebec.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. That so much of chapter four hundred and  
2 twenty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen  
3 hundred and one as relates to the powers and jurisdiction of  
4 trial justices in the town of Fayette in the county of Kenne-  
5 bec is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
