IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to provide for certain expenses of law terms of the
supreme judicial court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The chief justice or in his absence the senior
2 justice present at any law term of the supreme judicial court,
3 shall allow to the county in which any such term may be held,
4 such expenses as may be incurred on account of such law
5 term, which shall be paid by the State.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
