STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT authorizing the payment of an annuity by the city of
Portland to Lizzie A. Johnson.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. The city council of the city of Portland may
2 annually hereafter appropriate and pay to Lizzie A. Johnson,
3 widow of Charles A. Johnson, a former member of the fire
4 department of said city who on the twenty-sixth day of April,
5 A. D. 1903, received injuries while in the discharge of his
6 duty which resulted in his death, a sum not exceeding three
7 hundred dollars for the benefit of herself and family. Such
8 annuity may be granted to said Lizzie A. Johnson during
9 her widowhood or so long as she remains a resident of said
10 city of Portland.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
