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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to provide blanks, books and stationery for the  
municipal court in Newport.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. It shall be the duty of the county commissioners  
2 of the county of Penobscot to furnish and provide at the  
3 expense of said county, all books, blanks, and all necessary  
4 stationery and supplies required for the use of the municipal  
5 court in the town of Newport, in the transaction of the civil  
6 and criminal business of said court, including proper books  
7 for the record of all cases arising in said court, at a cost not  
8 exceeding one hundred dollars per year.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts, conflicting with this act,  
2 are hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall go into effect on the first day of  
2 April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and  
3 five.
