IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Meduxnekeag Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Medux-

- 2 nekeag Light and Power Company which were granted by
- 3 chapter one hundred and sixty-two of the Special Laws of
- 4 one thousand nine hundred and three, are hereby extended
- 5 for two years from the approval of this act and the persons
- 6 named in said act, their associates and successors shall have
- 7 all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them
- 8 by said act to be exercised in the same manner and for the
- 9 same purposes as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
