IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to authorize the Fort Halifax Power Company to furnish electricity for power purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the powers specified in its original

- 2 incorporation as recorded in the secretary of State's office,

- 5 pany is hereby authorized to make, generate, sell, distribute

Sect. 2. Said corporation may issue bonds for such 2 amounts as may be required, not exceeding one hundred and 3 fifty thousand dollars, and secure payment of such bonds by 4 mortgages upon the property and franchises of the company, 5 and may lease or sell its entire plant, property and franchises 6 to the Messalonskee Electric Company, which is hereby 7 authorized to make such purchase or lease.
