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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section 7, chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes relating to malicious mischief.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 7 of chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes is hereby  
2 amended by inserting in the second line thereof, after the  
3 words "transit point," the following: 'Reference point, stake,  
4 plug, hub, guard stake, bench mark, or other monument.'  
5 So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Whoever wilfully or maliciously disturbs, removes or  
7 destroys any transit point, reference point, stake, plug, hub,  
8 guard stake, bench mark, or other monument of any railroad  
9 location or survey, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding  
10 twenty-five dollars, or imprisonment not exceeding thirty  
11 days; and in addition shall be liable in an action of debt for  
12 the amount of damage done.'
