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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

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AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred sixty-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven, entitled, "An Act Creating the Fort Fairfield Village Corporation."

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred sixty-six of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-seven is hereby amended by striking out in the second and third lines thereof, the words "One" "Four" "Five" "Six" "Forty-three"; so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Section 1. The following described territory, namely:  
Lots numbered two, three, eight, nine, ten, eleven, twelve,

9 thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and seventy-nine, in the town of  
10 Fort Fairfield, according to Sawyer's Survey of township  
11 Letter D, in the first range, together with the inhabitants  
12 therein, be and the same are hereby created a body politic  
13 and corporate by the name of the Fort Fairfield Village Cor-  
14 poration.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
