STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to prohibit throwing sawdust, shavings, waste or refuse into Heath brook or its tributaries, in the town of Acton, York county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cast or throw into Heath brook
2 in the town of Acton, in the county of York, or into any of
3 the tributaries of said brook, any sawdust, shavings, bark or
4 other mill waste, or place or deposit such mill waste or other
5 refuse along the banks in such manner that the same shall
6 fall or be washed into said brook or its tributaries.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than fifty nor more
3 than one hundred dollars and costs for each offense.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
