STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT regulating the taking of clams in the town of North Haven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No clams shall be taken within the limits of the 2 town of North Haven by any person not residing in said 3 town. This section shall not interfere with any law relating 4 to the taking of shell fish for bait by fishermen.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of section I 2 of this act, shall for each offense, be fined not more than ten 3 dollars, or imprisoned not more than thirty days.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
