IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT regulating the taking of clams in the town of North  
Haven.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section 1. No clams shall be taken within the limits of the  
2 town of North Haven by any person not residing in said  
3 town. This section shall not interfere with any law relating  
4 to the taking of shell fish for bait by fishermen.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of section 1  
2 of this act, shall for each offense, be fined not more than ten  
3 dollars, or imprisoned not more than thirty days.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
