## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section thirty of chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to railroad branch tracks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty of chapter fifty-one of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word
- 3 "tracks," being the last word in the second line of said sec-
- 4 tion, the following words 'to any railroad station of another
- 5 corporation or to connect with another railroad, or,' so that
- 6 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 30. Any railroad corporation, under the direction 8 of the railroad commissioners, may locate, construct and 9 maintain branch railroad tracks to any railroad station of 10 another corporation or to connect with another railroad or

11 to any mills, mines, quarries, gravel-pits or manufacturing
12 establishments erected in any town or township, through
13 which the main line of said railroad is constructed, but not
14 within any city without the consent of the city council and
15 for that purpose said corporation shall have all the powers
16 and rights granted and be subject to all the duties imposed
17 upon it by its charter.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
