IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIVE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter twenty of the Revised Statutes, relating to burying grounds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section three of chapter twenty of the Revised Statutes is

- 2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "society" in
- 3 the first line thereof the words 'and any individuals, associa-
- 4 tion or corporation,' and also by inserting after the word
- 5 "society" in the last line of said section the words 'or by
- 6 such individuals, association or corporation,' so that said
- 7 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 3. Each town, parish, religious society and any 9 individuals, association or corporation, to which any ancient

10 or public burying ground belongs, shall keep a substantial 11 fence around it in good repair; and for neglect shall forfeit 12 not exceeding one hundred dollars to be applied as pre-13 scribed in the preceding section by such officers of such town, 14 or the officers or committee of such parish or society, or by 15 such individuals, association or corporation.'
