RESOLVE in favor of the city of Rockland, Me.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum
2 of eight hundred and four dollars to reimburse the city of
3 Rockland for the amount paid to families of soldiers during
4 the late war with Spain and the further sum of one hundred
5 and fifty dollars to reimburse said city for money paid for
6 medical attendance to soldiers and families during said war.
