STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of New Gloucester.

Resolved, That the State treasurer is hereby authorized and
2 directed to pay to the town of New Gloucester, the sum of
3 thirty dollars to reimburse said town for amount expended
4 for the medical attendance of one Carroll Hoyt, now
5 deceased, properly a charge of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Carroll Hoyt was born in Dixfield, Mass., on April 3, 1881. At the age of thirteen or fourteen he came to the State of Maine and he has not lived in any one place since long enough to gain a pauper residence. The town of New Gloucester, the last place he lived, was called upon to help him, and they ask to be reimbursed the amount of thirty dollars paid out on his account as a State charge.
