STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of State Normal Schools.

Resolved, that the sum of sixteen hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated to purchase text books for the State
3 normal schools, the same to be expended by the trustees of
4 said schools.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The text books in all the normal schools are in a very bad condition, some of them having been used by twelve different classes, and the incidental fund paid by each student is not sufficient to furnish said schools with books and other school supplies.
